WATER RESTRICTIONS:

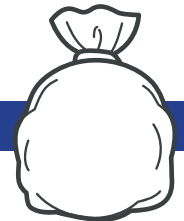


Pursuant to By-Law #2003-33. **Lawn and garden watering is only permitted between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for the months of June, July, August and September.**

Persons with odd street numbers can water on odd days of the month and persons with even street numbers can water on even days of the month.

A surcharge of \$50.00 will be added to your water bill for non-compliance. Thank you for your cooperation.

CLEAR GARBAGE BAG PROGRAM:



MANDATORY AS OF JULY 1, 2021

The Township of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen has switched to clear garbage bags for residential waste as of January 1, 2021. This program applies to curbside collection and all Havelock-Belmont-Methuen Transfer Stations. *Garbage bag tags are required for disposal*

The initial launch of the Clear Bag Program that began on January 1st, 2021 will come to an end and become mandatory on July 1, 2021.

Recyclable material must be removed from garbage bags. Collectors have the right to refuse pick up if the clear bag contains more than 10% recyclable material.
