Havelock Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Schedule 'C' Class Environmental Assessment

The Township of Havelock-Belmont-Methuen is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to plan for additional sanitary sewage capacity to service the Village of Havelock. Additional capacity is required to support growth forecasts to 2041 and beyond. The existing Havelock WWTP (719 Old Norwood Road, Havelock) which services the community, is nearing its rated capacity and may not be able to accommodate additional sanitary flows for future development.

The study is being conducted according to the requirements of a Schedule 'C' project under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (October 2000, amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015).

A Public Information Centre (PIC) has been planned to present details of the study, the results of the activities completed to-date, the preliminary preferred recommended solution to expand the existing Havelock WWTP, and to provide an opportunity to obtain your feedback on the study.

The Project Team encourages the public and stakeholders to participate in the planning process for this study. Given the current COVID-19 restrictions, the PIC will be hosted "virtually" through the Township's website. PIC material will be available on the website, and comments are invited from: Thursday, March 3, 2022 until Thursday, April 21, 2022.
